

What types of financial aid does Maplebrook School offer?

Cultural Diversity Scholarship

Maplebrook is committed to maintaining a culturally diverse student body. The Maplebrook Board of Trustees has approved money to accomplish this goal for qualified applicants.

Scholarships

Money for families that demonstrate need based on information from School and Student Services for Financial Assistance (SSS).

Jane Fernandez Scholarship

This scholarship is for day students enrolled at Maplebrook School.

Work Study Program

Student works on campus throughout the school year to earn money towards tuition.

Adopt A Student

Provides financial assistance to families experiencing financial difficulty during the school year that could result in withdrawal from the school.

Equestrian Scholarship

Awarded to students in need of financial assistance to join equestrian program.

Non-Need Based Scholarships

This scholarship program was created to recognize an individual student's special talent and/or accomplishment without being based on financial need.
