

Graduation Weekend Guide ~ 2020

We have made it through another year and in just a short time, it will be Graduation Weekend. In order to make your experience smooth and pleasurable, we have put together this information sheet to serve as a guide to events and activities throughout the weekend. It goes without saying that all events will be virtual. Please let us know if you have any questions.

- The weekend begins on Wednesday, June 3 and ends with Commencement on Sunday, June 7.
- Wednesday, Thursday and Friday will be Family/Teacher conferences. A schedule has been created and the format will be group progress meetings through the Zoom platform. All faculty/staff who worked with the student at a given time will join the meeting via Zoom link. Each meeting will be 25 minutes in length.
- Families are encouraged to set up private Zoom meetings with their student's mentor.
- Friday night is the Prom. It is a virtual event and will be loaded onto the school's YouTube channel. A link for viewing will be provided. Maplebrook Prom – the Movie will be launched at approximately 7:00 PM on June 5. The comment section will be available for viewers.
- We are holding the Student Awards ceremony via pre-recorded link on our YouTube channel on Saturday, June 6 @ 10:00 AM. Certificates and awards will be mailed to the students' homes. The comment section will be available for viewers.
- Commencement is Sunday, June 7. The video of the ceremony will be uploaded to the school's YouTube channel and ready to view at approximately 10:00 AM. The comment section will be available for viewers.
- We will have a Zoom chat room open directly after graduation in lieu of the reception line. It will be available for family and faculty/staff to wish the graduates well for approximately 20 minutes. After that time period, it will be opened up for the remainder of our guests to address the graduates.
